ASSYRTIKO

Assyrtiko, the "Riesling of Greece", has the distinction of being a white grape that ripens to high acidity and stonefruit characteristics. Typically grown on the island of Santorini it is achieving success in the hands of those respectful of its slightly volatile nature.

RODITIS

Roditis is the most widely produced white grape in Greece. Still, it is grown chiefly in the northern, high elevations of Peloponnesos, west of Athens. This varietal produces light, crisp whites with citrus characteristics.

MOSCHOFILERO

Most serious production of Moschofilero white wines is centered in the Mantinia plateau, a soil-rich plain in the center of the Peloponnesos, southwest of Athens. The grape produces wines of quiet character, their best attributes being elegance, crispness and subtle floral aromas.

AGIORGITIKO

Grown chiefly in the Nemea valley in the southern Peloponnesos, south of Athens, Agiorgitiko has certain similarities with Merlot. Having an abundance of "good" tannins they are outstanding candidates for graceful barrel aging.

Fruit and aromas can vary from medium ripe cherry to dark berry.

XYNOMAVRO

Xynómavro is best known for the role it plays in the wines of Naoussa in Makedonia, the very north of Greece. The name Xynó(sour) mavro(black) hints at some characteristics of the variety. Producing wines of high natural tannins and aromas from light cherry to dark berry, Xynómavro often compares to French Pinot Noir.

LIMNIO

Originating from the northern Aegean Islands, Limnio is widely produced in Makedonia in northern Greece. Its vines are hearty and late-ripening, producing wines of considerable body and extraction. Modern vinifications include its blending with Cabernet and Merlot.
